







X1 Large Armrest/Backrest Module Frame






Remove the corner module cushion, backrest cushion inserts, legs and hooks from the corner module frame.




**2** Screw the legs into the corner module frame.







Place the corner module frame on its side then align the labels and place the cushion on the frame.








Grab the corner module cover, align the module labels and secure the cover velcro in place.












Grab the armrest/backrest module cover, align the frame label with the cover label then tug the cover onto the frame and secure the velcro in place. Repeat.




Place the backrest cushion insert into the backrest cushion cover and close the zip. Repeat.





Align the wedge brackets to connect the armrest/backrest modules to the corner module and slide all the way down.






The armrest/backrest modules should line up with the corner module on each side if assembled correctly


To build out your Bangalow Sofa, install the hooks on the module and push all the way down.






Align the front and back of the seats then lift the next module onto the hooks to connect them together.

Repeat until all modules are connected.



Place your backrest cushions onto the modules.

#### Product Information and Care

#### LINING FABRIC

Regular Care (Weekly)

- Vacuum regularly using low suction.
- Protect from direct sunlight.

#### **Spot Cleaning**

- Remove any spills immediately by gently blotting any liquid with a clean cloth.
- Scoop up any solids before blotting the remaining liquid.
- Use a mild detergent to gently remove any loose soilage.
- · Do not scrub with a sti brush.
- Use a clean cloth to blot out any excess liquid.
- Avoid over wetting as this may result in a water mark.
- · Allow the fabric to air dry in a well ventilated area away from direct sunlight.

**NOTE:** PRETEST THE CLEANING METHOD ON A HIDDEN AREA OF THE SOFA. IF CHANGE IN COLOUR, OR TRANSFER DO NOT CONTINUE.


#### **PILLING**

Pilling can occur occasionally as a result of normal daily wear and should not be considered a fault. Fibre pills can be removed with a battery operated pilling tool, available from most haberdashery stores.

#### **REMOVABLE COVERS**

For correct care of the removable covers refer to the care label inside covers for additional cleaning instructions.
