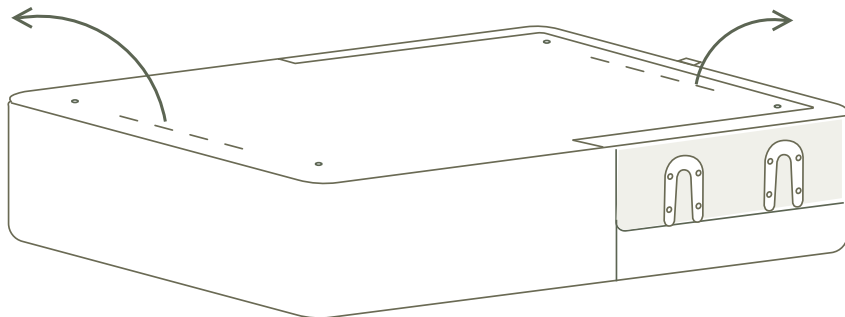
1. Take the components out of the bottom of the Chaise.

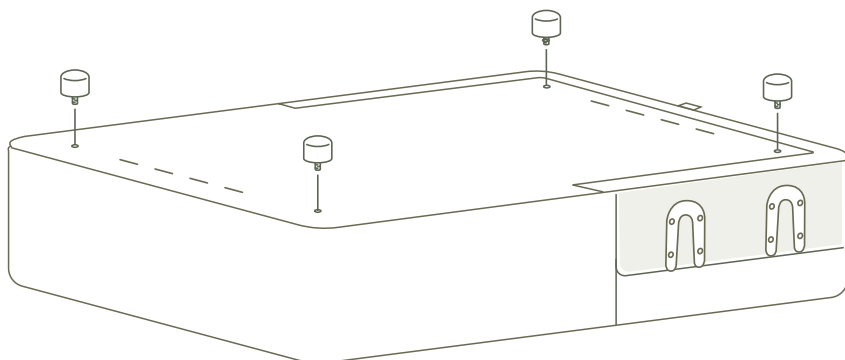

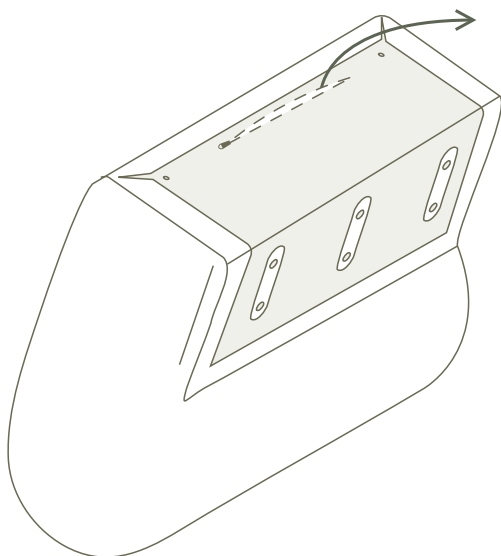
2. Screw the legs into the chaise frame.

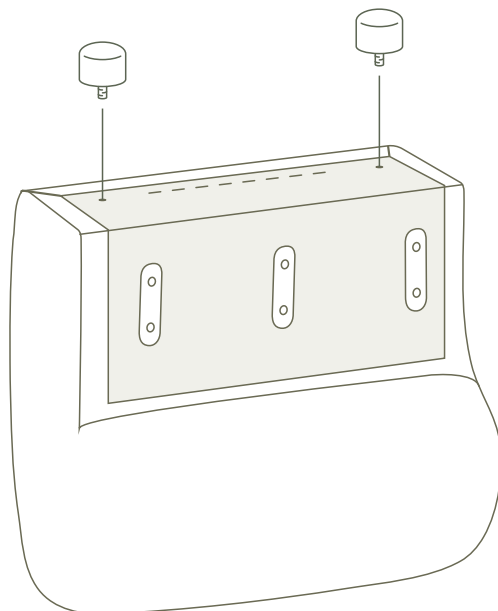


3. Remove the legs from the zipper pocket



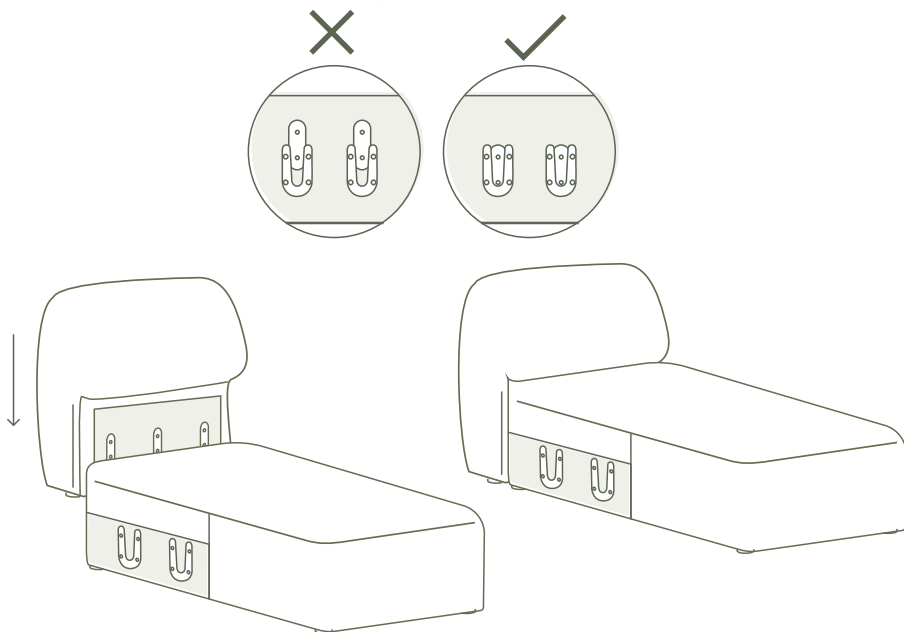

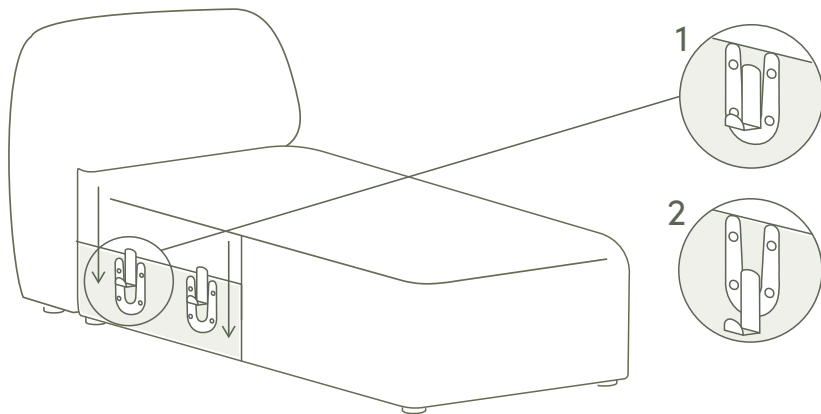
- 5.** Align the wedge brackets to connect the backrest module to the chaise module and slide all the way down.



- 6.** To build out your Bangalow Sofa, install the hooks on the module and push all the way down.



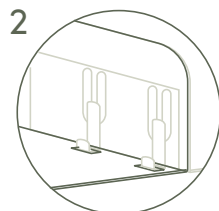
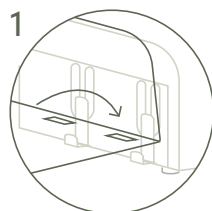
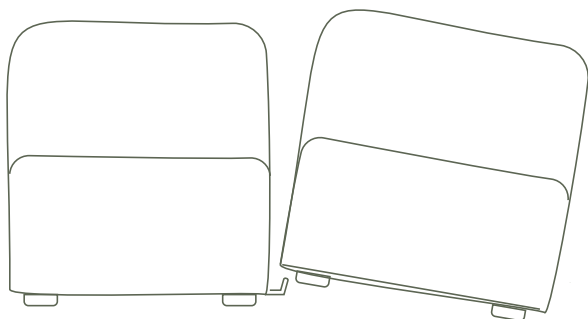

7. Align the backrests then lift the next module onto the hooks to connect them together.

Repeat until all modules are connected.



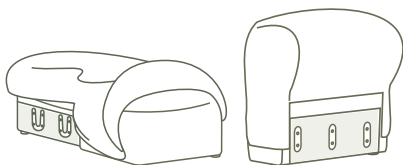
You will have 2-4 left over hooks upon completion of assembly

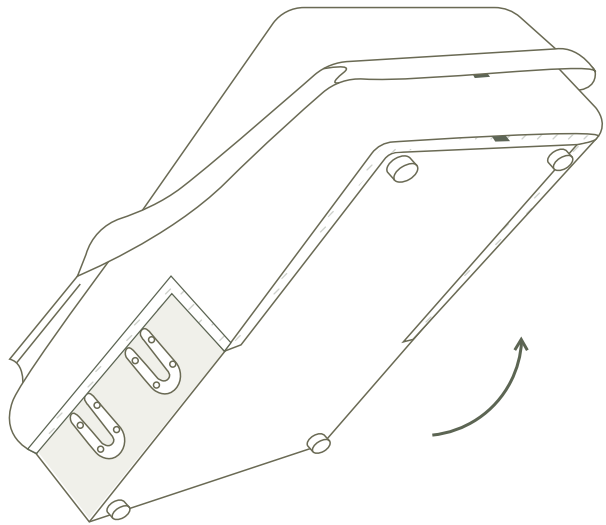
- 8.** Drape the cover over the chaise cushion and align the 4 corner seams.



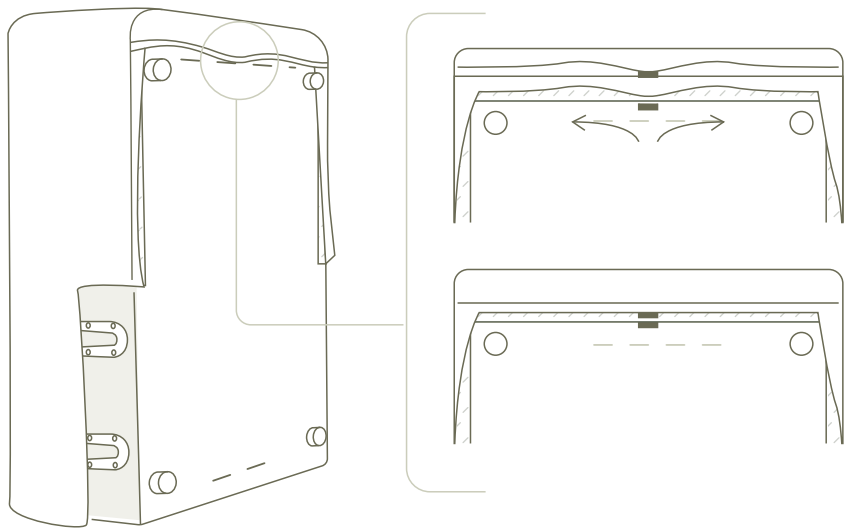

- 9.** Pull front cover down on front and sides



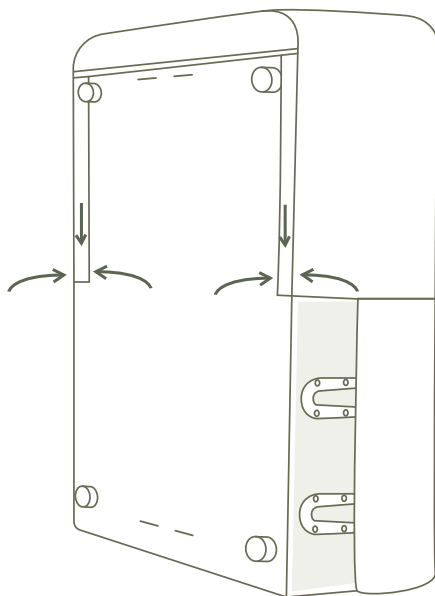
10. Lift up chaise so it stands on its back



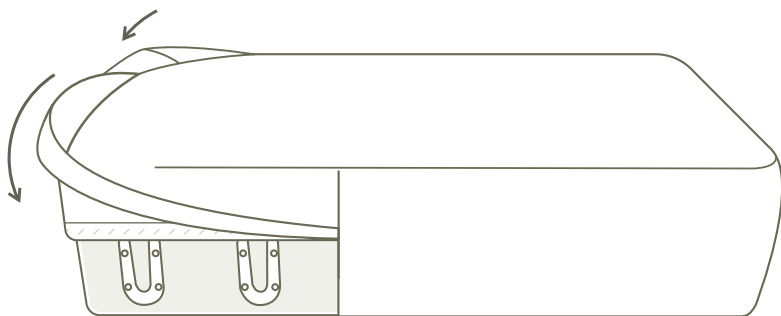
11. Align tags and secure the front velcro starting from the center working outward



12. Secure side velcro on the bottom edge

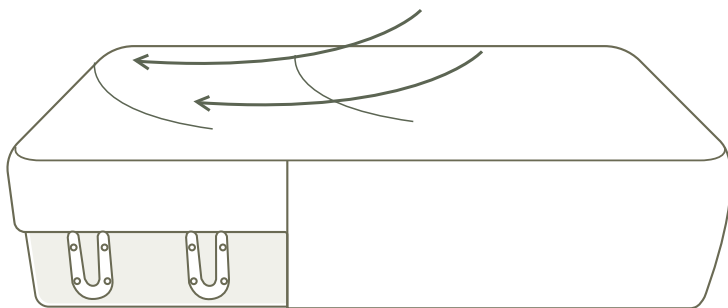


13. Ensure the corner seams align with the corner of the frame.



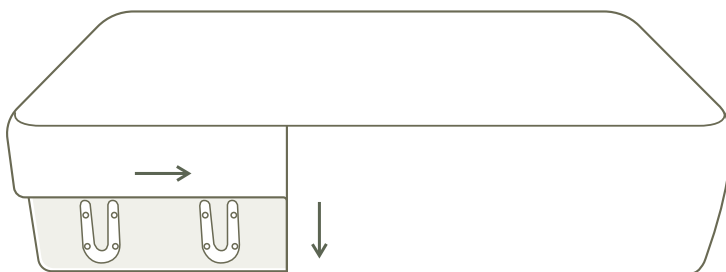

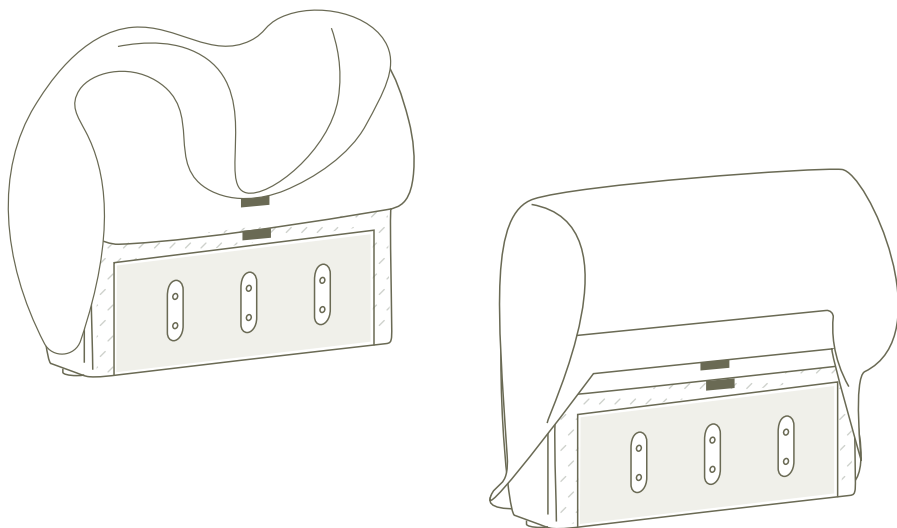

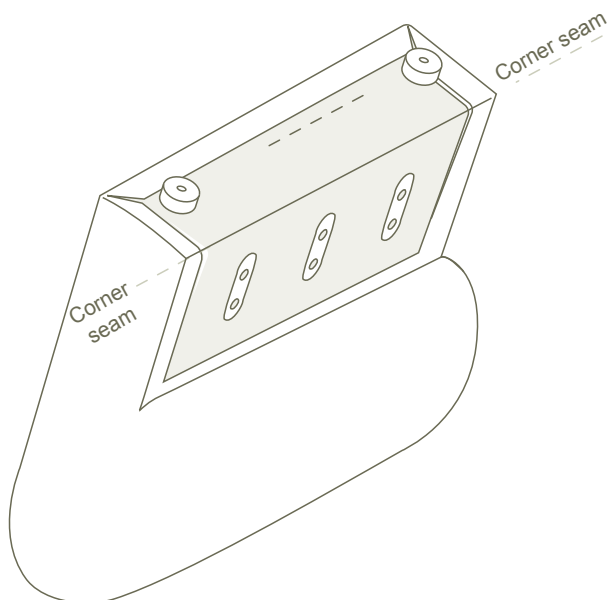
Secure the back edge and the side velcro



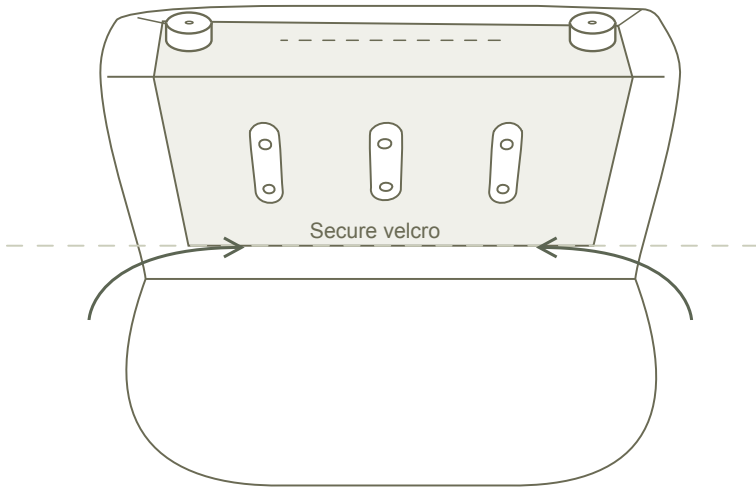
- 16.** Ensure Label on the frame and cover match and pull the cover over the frame



- 17.** Flip the frame over and secure the velcro starting with the bottom inside corners. Ensure the seam is lined up with the corner



18. Secure the remaining velcro.



Product Information and Care

LINING FABRIC

Regular Care (Weekly)

- Vacuum regularly using low suction.
- Protect from direct sunlight.

Spot Cleaning

- Remove any spills immediately by gently blotting any liquid with a clean cloth.
- Scoop up any solids before blotting the remaining liquid.
- Use a mild detergent to gently remove any loose soilage.
- Do not scrub with a stiff brush.
- Use a clean cloth to blot out any excess liquid.
- Avoid over wetting as this may result in a water mark.
- Allow the fabric to air dry in a well ventilated area away from direct sunlight.

NOTE: PRETEST THE CLEANING METHOD ON A HIDDEN AREA OF THE SOFA. IF CHANGE IN COLOUR, OR TRANSFER DO NOT CONTINUE.

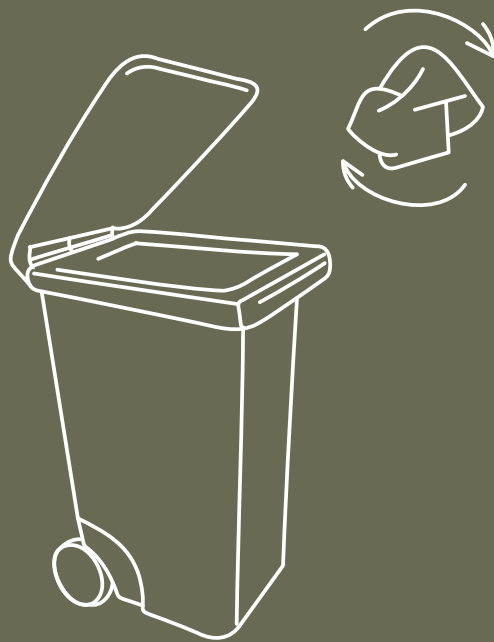
PILLING

Pilling can occur occasionally as a result of normal daily wear and should not be considered a fault. Fibre pills can be removed with a battery operated pilling tool, available from most haberdashery stores.

REMOVABLE COVERS

For correct care of the removable covers refer to the care label inside covers for additional cleaning instructions.
